

INDEX FOR *LOUISIANA ARCHAEOLOGY*, BULLETINS 1–50 (1974–2025)

The following is an index of articles published in *Louisiana Archaeology*, the peer-reviewed bulletin of the Louisiana Archaeological Society (LAS). This is an update of the last index, published in 1985 for the first 10 issues of *Louisiana Archaeology* (Moore 1985). The LAS published its inaugural issue of *Louisiana Archaeology* in 1974. Bulletin No. 50, the current issue, was published in 2025.

Articles in the bulletin are diverse and wide ranging, from original research and analyses to reports on artifacts and investigations, comments, reviews, and important

contributions on the archaeology of Louisiana, adjacent areas, and other regions. While articles on non-Louisiana topics of exceptional merit have been published, the focus of the LAS and *Louisiana Archaeology* has been to foster the scientific study, interpretation, and conservation of Louisiana’s archaeological resources, historic properties, sites, and cultural heritage.

The following 10 individuals have served as editors of the 50 issues of *Louisiana Archaeology* since 1974. Bulletins with an asterisk were co-edited.

The index is organized in three sections: the Author Index, Parish–Site Index, and List of Sites. The **Author Index** is presented alphabetically by the surname of primary authors. While *Louisiana Archaeology* is the annual bulletin of the LAS, publication has been irregular. The year of publication consequently does not consistently match the year of LAS membership for which a bulletin was issued. All articles are cited by the

actual year of publication. The year of publication is followed by the article title, corresponding bulletin number, and page numbers. Editor’s notes are added in brackets whenever appropriate.

The **Parish–Site Index** follows the Author Index and provides a list of sites that have appeared in *Louisiana Archaeology*, organized alphabetically by the parishes in which

sites are located. Site names are followed by the trinomial site number assigned by the Louisiana Office of Cultural Development, Division of Archaeology. Site numbers are in parentheses, followed by the author's surname, year of publication, and bulletin number in parentheses. The Author Index can be consulted for article titles. Articles on sites outside of Louisiana are presented according to the respective state at the end of the Parish–Site Index. The **List of Sites** that have appeared in *Louisiana Archaeology* is organized alphabetically by name. The corresponding site numbers in the List of Sites can be used with the Parish–Site Index and Author Index to find respective articles.

The index lists 310 articles that examine or reference more than 200 sites in 49 of Louisiana's 64 parishes. Some sites and parishes, such as Poverty Point World Heritage Site (16WC5) in West Carroll Parish, have received relatively more attention and coverage

in *Louisiana Archaeology*. Of course, the absence of a site or parish in this index does not mean that site is unimportant or the parish is void of archaeological sites or research. There are thousands of recorded sites in Louisiana, only a small fraction of which have been systematically investigated. Far fewer have been the subject of published research.

The Louisiana Division of Archaeology maintains an online database of Excavated Sites and a Bibliography of reports on sites in the state. Along with the index presented here, these are invaluable resources for archaeological research in Louisiana. The LAS website provides an online list of all bulletins and special publications, along with electronic (pdf) copies of all LAS *Newsletters*. Back issues of *Louisiana Archaeology* and special publications can be ordered on the LAS website at laarchaeologicalsociety.org, while out-of-print issues can be downloaded as electronic files.
